If you are worried what your children will do for the first two weeks of their summer vacation, please read on. ICS will be running a two week summer camp for children currently enrolled in pre-school through 11th grade. The camp will start Monday, June 14 and run through Friday, June 25th. Elementary camp (Pre-K to 5th Grade) will be in the morning from 8:30 AM to noon. Middle and High school camp will be in the afternoon from 1 PM to 5 PM. Scheduled activities promise educational value, relaxation, fun, and enjoyment under the theme "Summer Time".
